



BACKGROUND

- Inflammatory bowel diseases (IBD) are chronic recurrent inflammatory affections that mainly include Crohn's disease (CD) and ulcerative colitis (UC). Although the etiology remains unknown, it is suggested that an inappropriate inflammatory response to intestinal microbiome occurs in genetically susceptible patients.
- The incidence and prevalence rates of IBD have increased, including in Latin America. In the long term, they are responsible for structural damage that compromises patients' quality of life and have an impact on the morbidity and mortality of these patients.
- The long-term complications include stenosis, perforation, dysplasia and colorectal cancer.
- In order to avoid complications, an appropriate approach aiming clinical and endoscopic remission of patients is critical.
- To achieve this, it is necessary to have knowledge about IBD and the current therapeutic approaches.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- The primary goal of this course is to introduce the participant in the IBD world and also improve and update the treatment in physicians who already treat these patients.
- The course provides clinical, endoscopic end surgical aspects, the current available treatments and a closer contact with the experts in the IBD field.
